Question: Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 33, Bear Lake County, State of Idaho, be authorized to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of one million, five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2027, for the purposes stated below; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on March 19, 2024.

The school district does not anticipate increasing the tax burden to local patrons. Due to recent state legislation roughly \$850,000 will be sent to the school district to be used to offset patron costs on bonds, supplemental or plant facility levies. In the Bear Lake School District these additional funds must reduce our current levies. Our current Supplemental Levy is used for Technology, Maintenance, Custodial services, School Safety, and Extracurricular Activities, but not for building new or remodeling existing facilities.

It is therefore proposed that we increase the current Supplemental Levy of \$650,000 by an additional \$850,000 (\$650,000 Current Supplemental levy + \$850,000 additional State funding = \$1,500,000 total) to capture the funds expected from the state. It is not the intention of the school district to increase the tax burden of our patrons.

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$33.87 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy replaces an existing levy that will expire on June 30, 2025. If the proposed legislation does not pass, the commitment of the school district once again is to not increase tax rates from the 2022 tax year levels.

The levy would maintain current district funding, establish a building fund, and keep taxes at the 2022 tax year level. The purposes for which the proposed levy revenues will be used and the approximate amount of levy funds to be allocated to each use are as follows:

The Board of Trustees of Soda Springs Jt. School District #150 Caribou, Bear Lake, Bonneville Counties, Idaho, is seeking authorization to levy a Supplemental Levy for the following purposes in the amount of \$993,000.00 to be allocated for Teacher and Staff salaries, and benefits, a School Resource Officer and all lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the schools of the District for a total amount of \$993,000.00 for one year.

QUESTION:

Shall the Board of Trustees of the Soda Springs Jt. School District #150 Caribou, Bear Lake, Bonneville Counties, Idaho, be authorized to levy a supplemental levy, as permitted by law in Section 33-802(3), Idaho Code, in the amount of Nine Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Dollars (\$993,000), for one (1) year commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025 as provided in the resolution of the Board of Trustees of Soda Springs School District #150 adopted on February 28, 2024?

Currently, the District collects a supplemental levy authorized in the amount of \$698,000 that costs the taxpayer \$52.59 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, which will expire when the proposed levy goes into effect. The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$75.01 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions.
